## Rusty Nail

1960's Drambuie & 1960's Johnnie Walker Red Label

*Thought to originate at the British Industries Fair in 1937 but reached its peak of popularity in the 1960's as the go-to cocktail of The Rat Pack*

## Japanese Old Fashioned

Suntory Old 1975 Ocean Expo. Edition, home-made Japanese bitters, demerara sugar

*With the first Japanese malt whisky distillery constructed in 1923 (Yamazaki), Suntory recently celebrated 100 years of Japanese whisky production*

## Sazerac

1980's Remy Martin V.S.O.P. Champagne Cognac, Rittenhouse Rye, absinthe, bitters

*Invented by the apothecary Antoine Peychaud at his shop in New Orleans in 1838*

## Rob Roy

1990's Johnnie Walker Blue Label, home-made sweet vermouth, orange bitters

*Created by New York's Waldorf Astoria Hotel in 1894 to celebrate the opening of the Broadway show "Rob Roy"*

## Cosmo

1980's Stanislav Vodka, home-made orange curacao, lime, cranberry

*Widely perceived to be a more modern creation, there is a recipe for a "cosmopolitan daisy" which appears in "Pioneers of mixing in elite bars" published in 1934*
